Weekly Requirements and Commitment

1st & 2nd Company

Must take 3 ballet classes, 1 contemporary class, 1 jazz class, and Stretch and Conditioning of the appropriate level weekly Company rehearsals - Thursdays 7:45-9:15pm & Saturdays 9:00am-3:00pm

**Saturday ballet counts toward the required 3 ballet.

Apprentice Company

Must take 2 ballet classes, 1 contemporary class, and 1 jazz class of the appropriate level weekly.

Company rehearsal- Thursdays 7:45-9:00pm

Junior Company

Must take 2 ballet classes, 1 contemporary class, and 1 jazz class of the appropriate level weekly.

Company rehearsal- Thursdays 5:30-6:30pm

Training Company

Must take 1 ballet class, 1 contemporary class, and 1 jazz class of the appropriate level weekly. Company rehearsal- Thursdays 5:15-6:00pm

Registering for EDDYE is a commitment that requires consistent attendance from September - June. Consistent attendance is required for all ballet, contemporary, jazz classes and company rehearsals..

All youth ensemble members should be prepared for Saturday rehearsals during Nutcracker season.

August 12 & 14 and August 19 & 21
**Dancers are required to attend 3 out of 4 days

1st and 2nd Companies-

August 12-16 and August 19-23

**Dancers are required to attend all 8 days. If unable to attend, they are not eligible to participate in choreography learned during absence.
